Fannings: Best and below best types were a good market and sold at firm rates. Others met with fair demand at little easier levels. Plainer types were difficult of sale.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to dearer rates following quality. There were however, some withdrawals particularly in the plainer category.
