Leaf offerings consisted of 54,537 packages. Prices were generally around last levels. Few good lines inclined. Leaf withdrawals stood at 41% as against 36% last week.

LEAF: Cleaner well-made brokens were about firm. Prices inclined when buyers competed to fulfill their quota. Mediums were about steady. Lower types were often unsaleable. Selective best brokens sold between Tk.273/- – Tk.360/-. Northern brokens ranged between Tk.210/- – Tk.244/-.


Well-made fannings fetched about last rates. Few good lines appreciated. Mediums maintained its level. Lower sorts often remained unsold. Selective best fannings sold between Tk.271/- – Tk.345/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.210/- – Tk.245/-


