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TEA MARKET REPORT - Sale 03 held on Monday, 19th May, 2025

CTC LEAF: 23,903 packages of tea on offer met with a better demand.

BROKENS/FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring varieties continued to meet with a strong demand at firm to slightly dearer rates following competition and these could be quoted between Tk.270/- and Tk.300/-. Below best varieties were a good market and were about steady in line with quality selling between Tk.230/- and Tk.250/-. All others met with a little more demand at firm to slightly easier rates and these could be quoted between Tk.200/- and Tk.220/-. BLF teas sold fairly well and sold between Tk.160/- and Tk.220/-.

DUST: 4,426 packages of tea on offer met with quite a good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at slightly easier rates. Their Mediums sold irregularly following

quality. Plain/BLF Dust met with an improved demand and were fully firm to slightly dearer. Blenders lent good support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: There was a little more demand this week from all sections of the market. The best varieties continued to sell at firm to slightly dearer rates in line with quality. Blenders again lent strong support with Loose tea buyers operating more actively.

Dusts sold well.



There was good demand. Assams were irregularly easier following a seasonal decline in quality. Medium and plainer Dooars sold around last levels. Local buyers and Western India buyers operated on clean and brighter liquoring varieties. Hindustan Unilever was active in both categories with strong activity on brighter liquoring Assam dust grades. Tata Consumer Products showed limited interest on plainer sorts. Exporters were active on bolder brokens.

COONOOR SALE 20- 19TH MAY, 2025

DEMAND: - Good demand for the best and good category, others continue to meet with reduced demand. MARKET: - The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 68.73 %(1280621.31kgs) of the total offering of 1863312.73Kgs. Larger broken grades declined in value by Rs 4 to 6, the remainders eased by Rs 4 to 8 or more. Larger percentage of teas remain unsold in this segment. Limited buying from exporters. Major blenders were very choosy and internal buyers were selective along with the upcountry buyers. BUYING PATTERN: - The major blenders off take was 50.64% of the total CTC leaf sold.
