

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 31 HELD ON DECEMBER 08, 2025

49,418 packages leaf were advertised for sale. There was a strong demand at firm to dearer rates as prices appreciated by Tk. 1/3. Leaf withdrawals stood at 29% as against 28% last week.

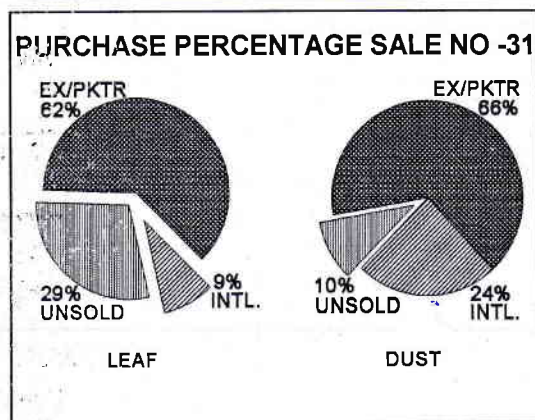
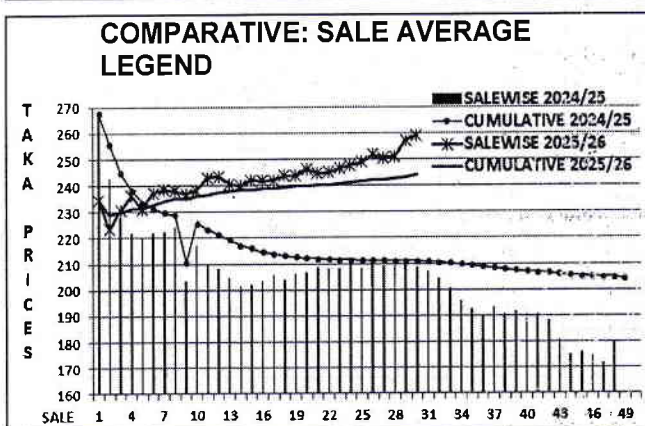
LEAF: Better teas were well competed for as prices remained about firm to dearer than last. Mediums gained a little. Withdrawals were limited to the lower teas. Selective best broken fetched between Tk.286/- – Tk.349/-. Northern broken sold between Tk.232/- – Tk.245/-. There were fair withdrawals.

Cleaner well made and the fannings with a good cup were about firm. Prices often inclined by Tk.1/3 later in the sale. Selective best lines sold between Tk.283/- – Tk.329/-. Northern fannings ranged between Tk.240/- – Tk.248/-

DUST: 9,940 packages were on offer. Strong demand led to mostly dearer rates. Well made dusts and the powdery lines gained by Tk. 5/6. Dusts withdrawals stood at 10% as against 13% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 3,108 packages were on offer. 59% sold and 41% remained unsold.

COMMENTS: Prices improved after a hesitant opening when rates were easier than last. With the progress of sale, prices hardened and levels moved upwards when most rates were firm to dearer. Northern teas mostly sold between Tk.240/- – Tk.244/- but there were more withdrawals than last. Major packeteers were active as well as the local traders.
