

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 32 HELD ON DECEMBER 15, 2025

Leaf offerings stood at 46,453 packages. Demand continued to remain strong with prices being firm to dearer. Leaf withdrawals stood at 24% as against 29% last week.

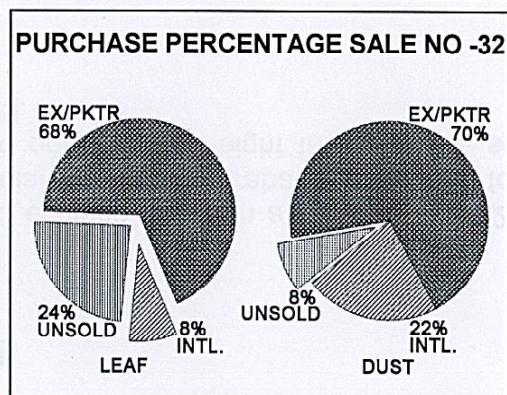
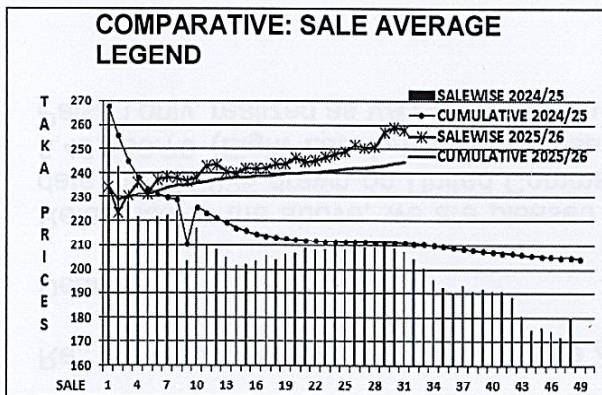
LEAF: Good brokenes were mostly firm to dearer by Tk. 2/3. Very bold lines remained unsold. Mediums inclined by Tk. 1/3. Lower types saw better interest at around last rates. High priced teas however often were withdrawn. Selective best lines sold between Tk.286/- – Tk.341/-. Northern brokenes were firm and sold between Tk.240/- – Tk.249/-.

Better fannings were generally firm to dearer by Tk.2/3. Mediums sold similarly. Plainer lines attracted more interest and often sold between Tk.245/- – Tk.248/-. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.284/- – Tk.334/-. Northern fannings were firm to dearer and sold between Tk.240/- – Tk.251/-.

DUST: 8,745 packages were on offer. Strong demand led to mostly dearer rates. Cleaner sorts gained by Tk. 3/5. Powdery lines were strong.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 2,075 packages were on offer. 57% sold and 43% remained unsold.
