

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 33 HELD ON DECEMBER 22, 2025

50,682 packages leaf were on offer. Strong demand once again led to a firm to dearer market. Leaf withdrawals stood at 27% as against 24% last week.

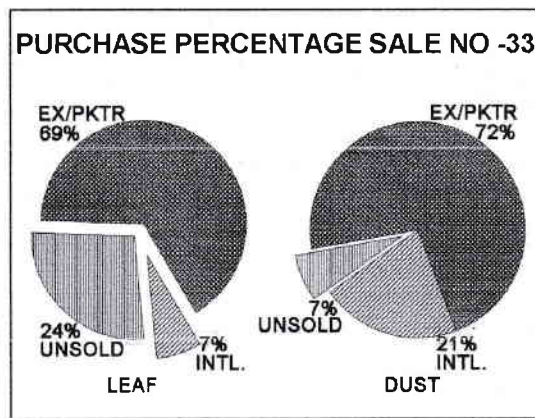
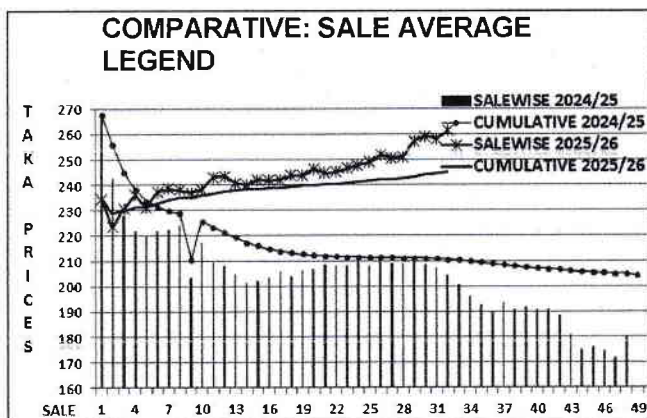
LEAF: Better brokens met with a strong demand at generally firm to dearer rates. Mediums too inclined. Lower types met with improved demand. Selective best brokens sold between Tk.286/- – Tk.342/-. Northern brokens were well received at between Tk.238/- – Tk.257/-.

Cleaner fannings met with a strong demand at firm to little dearer rates. Mediums also gained. Plainer lines sold at around last rates. Selective best lines sold between Tk.287/- – Tk.341/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.238/- – Tk.257/-.

DUST: 10,493 packages were on offer. Strong demand led to the market to appreciate over last levels. Cleaner types and the powdery lines gained.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 2,484 packages were on offer. 57% sold and 43% remained unsold.
