Brokens: Clean good liquorering types were keenly sought after by all sections of the market and sold at rates generally around last. Mediums and the plainer types sold well but tended slightly easier.

Fannings: Best and below best types were a fairly strong market and sold at mostly firm rates. Medium and the plainer types were a good market at firm to slightly easier rates following quality.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Sold readily at around last levels.
