

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 36 HELD ON JANUARY 12, 2026


Leaf offering in this sale stood at 45,874 packages. Good teas were in strong demand initially but declined towards close. Leaf withdrawals stood at 29% as against 30% last week.

LEAF: Better brokens were firm to little dearer when the market opened but prices slackened as the sale progressed. Others were lower than last. Selective best brokens were easier and sold between Tk.286/- – Tk.313/-. Northern brokens ranged between Tk.232/- – Tk.250/-.

Good fannings were initially a fair market but eased later in the sale. Mediums were an easier market. Plainer lines sold at around last rates but met with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.285/- – Tk.303/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.235/- – Tk.250/-.

DUST: 9,470 packages were on offer. Well made and those with a good cup with generally firm to little dearer. Lower types and those with a dull cup eased. Few lines remained unsold.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 2,661 packages were on offer. 45% sold and 55% remained unsold.



SALE NO: Sale 37 will be held on January 19, 2026 Monday at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram and will consist of 49,930 packages of leaf and 11,629 packages of dust.

OUR CATALOGUE: Sale no. 36 Avg. Tk. 261.93 sold 71.86%.

COMMENTS: There was a good demand for the better teas with a clean cup at firm to little dearer rates but eased later in the sale. Others were mostly easier. There were fair withdrawals for teas of a poor make and liquor. Most major packeteers were quite active.
