Demand: Good demand.

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A small weight of well made, good liquorizing types available, sold well at firm to little easier rates. Mediums were about steady. Plain and poor types met with selective demand and suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: A nominal weight of clean, good liquorizing types offered, were readily absorbed at firm to little easier rates. Mediums met with a fair demand and sold at firm to Tk. 2/3 below last following quality. Plainer types were easier with considerable withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with fairly good demand at firm to little easier rates.
