31,024 packages leaf were advertised for sale. Prices opened at firm to dearer rates which eased a little towards close. Leaf withdrawals stood at 48% as against 43% last week.


LEAF: Blackish well made brokens with a good cup continued to dominate prices which were fully firm to little dearer. Mediums and the plainer lines were about firm. Selective best lines sold between Tk.283/- – Tk.350/-. Northern brokens were firm on last, selling between Tk.160/- – Tk.222/-.


Well made fannings were firm. Mediums fetched around last rates with several lines gaining on last. Selective best lines sold between Tk.280/- — Tk.305/-. Northern fannings were firm to dearer, selling between Tk.160/- — Tk.234/-.

DUST: 4,398 packages were on offer. Cleaner and powdery lines inclined. Others sold at around last rates.

<u>OLD SEASON:</u> 18,886 packages were on offer. Only few lines sold between Tk.160/- slightly more. <u>SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION:</u> 1,866 packages were on offer. 27% sold and 73% remained unsold.

Arrivals are improving and after the Eid holidays, offering should increase to a large extent.
