## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 05 HELD ON June 02, 2025

31,239 packages leaf were up for sale. There was a fair demand at generally easier rates than last with prices dipping more towards close. Leaf withdrawals stood at 43% as against 48% last week.

**LEAF:** Best broken were generally a lower market as price declined by Tk. 5/10. Mediums and the plainer lines shed similarly. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.290/- – Tk.350/-. Good demand prevailed for the Northern broken and these sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.215/-.

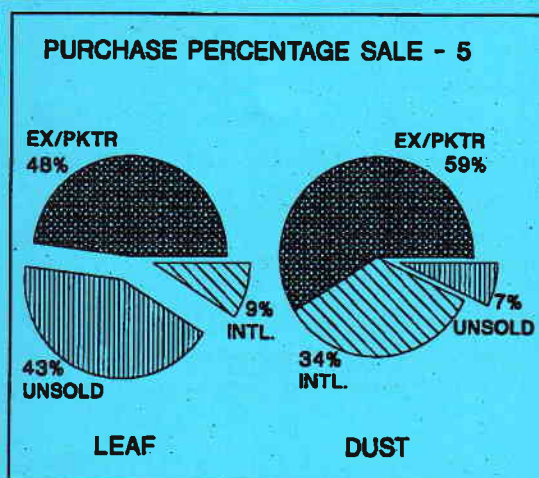
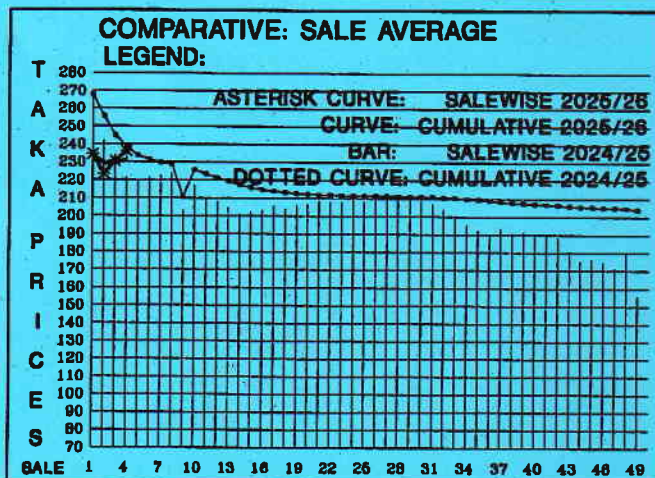
Better fannings were easier than last, depreciating by around Tk. 10/- or more. Others shed little more. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.275/- – Tk.283/-. Northern fannings ranged between Tk.160/- – Tk.217/-.

**DUST:** 6,460 packages were on offer. There was a good demand at around last levels. Powdery lines often gained.

**OLD SEASON:** 3,325 packages were on offer. Only few lines sold at Tk.160/-.

**SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION:** 2,264 packages were on offer. 38% sold and 62% remained unsold.

**The culture and preparation of tea**

In Ceylon, after rather heavy prune, the bush is left to grow till the shoots are so long that the new wood has turned from green to red at the base. This new growth is then plucked back or, tipped to about 4in. above the pruning level. A second 'tipping', still higher, may follow, after which plucking begins and this is above a big leaf. Hence to pluck two leaves and a bud, three leaves are allowed to grow and the lowest leaf is left on the bush at plucking time. Thus two plucking systems are presented, top-pruning annually or biennially as in Assam, followed by flat plucking, against heavier pruning at longer intervals, followed by 'tip-ping', which resembles the Assam top-prune, and then plucking above leaf as in Ceylon. Perhaps with the lighter pruning in months to two years, closer plucking might pay.
