MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 05 HELD ON JUNE 01, 2026

38,055 packages leaf along with 928 packages of old season leaf were offered for sale. There was a good demand which declined sharply towards the end. Leaf withdrawals stood at 17% as against 19% in the last sale two weeks ago.

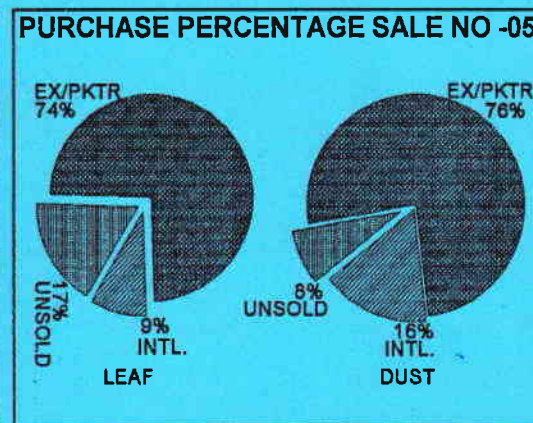
LEAF: Better brokens were an easier market as prices declined by Tk.5/7. Mediums shed similarly. Lower types depreciated by Tk.8/10. Selective best lines sold between Tk.304/- – Tk.355/-. Northern brokens were in strong demand and sold between Tk.240/- – Tk.272/-. Levels eased towards close.

Good fannings were well sought after at lower rates than last. Mediums and the plainer lines shed by upto Tk.10/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.314/- – Tk.376/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.240/- – Tk.289/-.

DUST: 8,807 packages were on offer. There was a good demand at lower rates than last.

OLD SEASON: 983 packages were offered for sale but remained unsold.

The culture and preparation of tea

The climate has an effect on the tea tree as a seed bearer. As described earlier, the setting of the seed depends on the phasic growth of the leaf and accordingly in Assam the seed matures mainly at the end of the season, from September to early November. In Ceylon, South India and java, where the phases of leaf growth are more evenly distributed over the year the seed can be gathered monthly. In Ceylon about 10 percent of the seed crop come in January, nearly 6 two-thirds between May and September and about 5 percent in each of the other months. It is generally considered that Assam seed is preferable to that grown nearer the equator, and in Africa the seed of Nyasaland, which matures from February to April is thought to be better than that grown in equatorial Africa.

Certain minor aspects of the effect of climate on tea growth may be mentioned here. Thus the effect of frost, hail and lightening are all hazards which have to be met from time to time.
