

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 19 HELD ON SEPTEMBER 07, 2026

50,489 packages of leaf that came under the hammer met with easier rates. Withdrawals stood at 24% as against 32% last week.

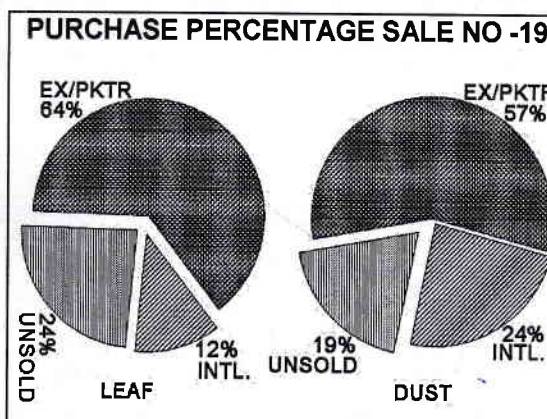
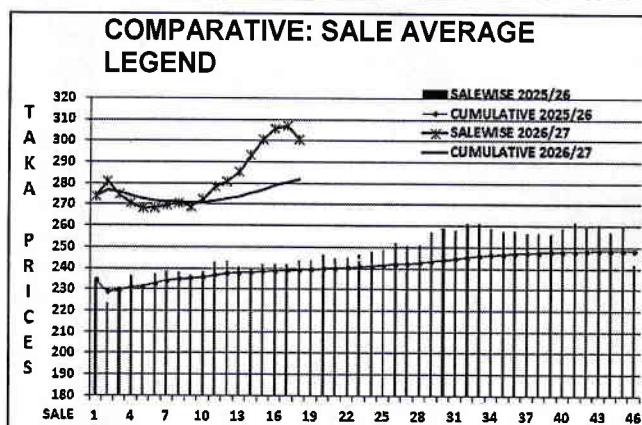
LEAF: Best brokenes were mostly easier by Tk.5/6. Good and medium types were about firm to often slightly easier. Plainer types eased by Tk.6/8. Northern brokenes where sold were easier by Tk.5/10. Selective best varieties sold around Tk.321/- – Tk.385/-.

Best and good fannings were generally easier by Tk. 4/5 whilst medium types declined Tk.3/4. Plainer fannings shed more and were easier by Tk.6/10. Northernns followed a similar trend and declined Tk.6/10 or more. Selective best fannings sold between Tk.319/- – Tk.325/-.

DUST: Offerings comprised of 9,602 packages. There was good demand but prices were generally easier. Withdrawals stood at 19% against 10% last week.

Supplement: 865 packages on offer met easier rates. 56% sold with 44% remaining unsold.
