

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 18 HELD ON AUGUST 31, 2026

Offerings comprised of 54,586 packages leaf. There was demand at much lower rates than last with a fair quantity remaining unsold. Withdrawals stood at 32% as against 16% last week.

LEAF: Most broken eased by Tk. 5/10 and occasionally more for the better types. Plainer types shed Tk.5/6 and so did the northern broken. Selective best varieties sold between Tk.320/- – Tk.366/-.

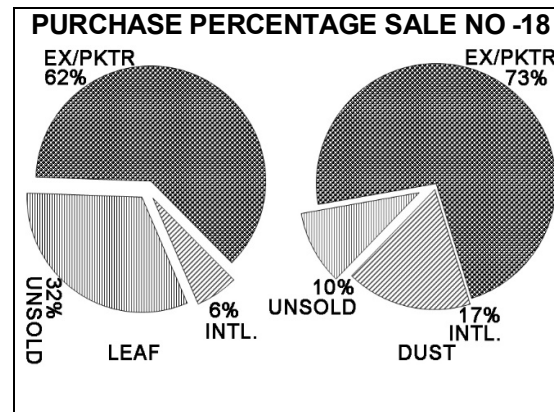
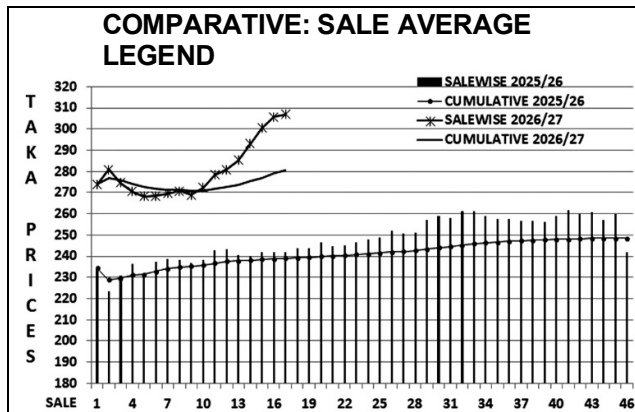
Fannings also declined by Tk.5/8 with the selective best easing slightly more. Plainer types shed Tk.4/5. Northern fannings met easier rates of Tk.5/6. Selective best types sold at around Tk.328/- – Tk.335/-.

DUST: There was 8,699 packages were on offer. Good demand led to firm to slightly easier rates. Withdrawals stood at 10% as against 21% last week.

OLD SEASON: 223 packages on offer met selective interest and a few lots sold at Tk.256/- – Tk.258/-.

Supplement: There was 845 packages on offer. 82% sold with 18% remaining unsold.
