**Brokens:** Well made good liquoring types sold well but eased by Tk. 5/7 from last. Medium and the plainer types shed more often by Tk. 7/8 and occasionally a little more following quality.

**Fannings:** Clean good liquoring types were well supported by all sections of the market at levels generally Tk. 5/7 below last. Others eased a little more.

**B/L Teas:** Sold well at rates Tk. 10/12 lower than last. There were a few withdrawals.

**Dust:** Met with a good demand at easier rates. Cleaner types eased by Tk. 5/7 whilst others shed more. CD's were generally easier than last. There were some withdrawals.

**Comment:** Offerings witnessed an easier market this week following lower limits held by the Blenders and weaker support from the Loose Tea Traders. Prices for all descriptions declined especially the B/L Teas which eased quite substantially. Dusts were an easier market. There were a few withdrawals.
